BELIEF IN A JUST WORLD AND ACADEMIC **DISHONESTY OF UNIVERSITY STUDENTS**

**ABSTRACT** 

Who cheats? Everyone? Academic dishonesty (AD) is a global plague, but it is not

universal. Do student views of justice influence their likelihood of cheating? This study

examines college students from a large regional university in the southwest of USA. We

examined both student attitudes towards academic dishonesty and behaviors as well as

student views towards justice using the scale from the Belief in a Just World. We found

significant differences exist both in attitudes towards cheating, but also how those views

interact with the Belief in a Just World. Results are discussed, limitations are mentioned,

and a research agenda in Academic Dishonesty is outlined.
